**III. Guest Presentation – Gigi Bate, Public Health Nurse, YHS Clinic**

YHS has a school health aid and a school nurse. The school nurse deals with case management. The school aid handles bandaids etc. Some of the areas that the YHS Clinic handles includes first aid, emergency care, medications with doctors orders, immunizations, skin tests, and hearing and vision tests. VA state law requires that vision and hearing tests be done in 10<sup>th</sup> grade and with the help of parent volunteers, the YHS Clinic checks all students. The office also educates students who may have a health issue such as a sprained ankle and how best to treat it. The Clinic wants parents to know that OTC medicine is allowed for the student to take. If students have no insurance, the office also tries to help students get necessary health care. The clinic staff trains APS staff on how to use epi-pens etc. if the clinic staff is not available. And, finally, the YHS clinic responds to outbreaks, such as measles. If your student has any health care issues, please contact the clinic.
