

# YORKTOWN HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION PARTY

## Graduation Party Rules



1. All students graduating from Yorktown High School are invited, including any who attend choice programs such as HB Woodlawn and Arlington Tech.
2. The PTA STRONGLY ENCOURAGES parents to drop off and pick up students at the State Theater. Parking is very limited around the State Theatre due to construction occurring next door and police are very quick to ticket/tow. For everyone's convenience, the State Theatre will have a carpool loop in their parking lot immediately next to the building. More details on drop-off/pick-up instructions will follow.
3. Students must attend with some form of photo ID to enter the party (a student ID is fine). Chaperones will check-in students based upon a list of ticket purchasers, so a photo ID will be required to verify each attendee.
4. Tickets will be available for purchase at the party (**only with a Yorktown School ID**), however, the PTA recommends that students purchase tickets in advance to speed entry and to allow us to plan for food, activities, etc., for all who attend.
5. Students may bring a small bag (no larger than 8" x 11" x 3") into the party. Students will have to check any bag larger than that at the coat check at the State Theater. Chaperones will search all bags and no outside beverages will be allowed.
6. No alcohol or other illicit substances (including non-medical use of prescription drugs and any form of CBD or marijuana) are permitted. Anyone who appears to be under the influence of any illicit substance will be denied admittance or removed from the party and parents will be called to pick up their student.
7. No tobacco use is permitted – no smoking, no vaping, or use in any form.
8. No pocketknives or other weapons of any kind.
9. Students who leave the party before the end will not be allowed to return.
10. Failure to comply with instructions or direction from State Theater security staff or PTA chaperones is grounds for removal from the party.

### **Finally, remember to Stay Classy Yorktown:**

- Please respect the State Theatre's facilities
- Attire will be comfortable going out clothes, but please no revealing or degrading clothing.
- Use respectful language around chaperones, State Theatre staff, Yorktown staff, and your peers.
- No one wants to see excessive PDA. Show respect to your peers and yourself by keeping it appropriate.
